 mercy and passion to grant remission of all my sinnes & finally left everlasting
 and my body I comyt to the earth to be buried in Christian burrowe at
 the discretion of myne exors & admors & whome god shall appoint
 the same, And touching my temporall estate wch god of his goodnes hath
 lent me in this lyfe I dispose the same as followeth to witte I give and
 bequeath to Thomas Wright my eldest sone all my messuages Lande
 Tenement & hereditament situate lying & being in the parish of Stenham
 aforesaid to have and to hold the said messuages Lande Tenement and
 hereditament wch ther apperteyne unto the said Thomas & his assignes for and
 during the tyme of his naturall lyfe, and after his decease to the first
 issue male of his body lawfully begotten, or to be begotten, for tyme of lyfe
 of such issue male, and from & after the decease of such issue male wch out
 issue male of his body unto the second issue male of the body of the said
 Thomas to be begotten, and soe in like sorte unto the thirde issue male of the
 body of the said Thomas to be begotten, and for want of such issue male of the
 body of the said Thomas I give and bequeath all the said messuages Lande
 Tenement & hereditament wch ther apperteyne unto within wright my sone
 & his assignes during the tyme of his naturall lyfe, & after his decease to
 the first issue male of the body of the said within begotten or to be begotten, &
 after the decease of such issue male, to the said issue male of the body of the said
 within begotten or to be begotten, and for want of such issue, the Remainder
 thereof to the right heirs of the said within for ever, the I give to my wife all
 my wearing apparell, the I will that my debts being payed & my funerall
 expences discharged, that all my money good & chattell, Arrentall of house
 hold and other thing movable shall be parted & equally divided by some within
 wchome I make sllt exors & admors of the said my last will, and to be divided into
 four parts & equally distributed unto & amongst Thomas my sone, within my
 sone, & Jane & margaret my daughters, And if they doe not lyege, then to rest lyege
 for their parts the I give to my sone in ladv for his wode & my daughter Thomas
 his wife vij^s and I doe hereby revoke all former wills by me made, in witness whereof
 I have subscribed my hand & seal the day & year first above written in
 the presence of, within
