Chamber together with the fether bedd fether bolster
Houset. and blanket. Now upon. Item I give
my Daughter Mary six pence of lawfull money of
England. Item I give my Daughter Ann six pence
of lawfull money of England. Item I give my
Daughter Marth one my fether stool and fether
Tobell. Item I give my Daughter Gracet two
Hundred six pence above of good and lawfull
money of England. Item I give to my grandchild
William Browne my best best. Item I give to
my grandchild Marthret Browne one of my best
toen stool and pillow and pillow bedd. and one furnished
stool. Item all the rest of my goods I give to my
son Fithred to pay my debts and bequeste here by me
made. and to see my body decently buried and my
funerall charges borne. and I nominate him my sole
Executor to give my last will. and I have declared
it to be my last will in the presence of those whose
names are here under written. In witness whereof
I the said Ann Turner have here to this my last
will and Testament set my hand and seal this
seventeenth day of July in the year of our Lord God
one thousand six hundred and two and fortified
