 goodes and chattells (as itt hath pleased god to bestowe on me) my mynde and will is that
 after my debted payes and funerall expences discharged they be and maye to be
 and be so as ~~presented~~ in these presented goodes mentioned and declared in manner and forme
 following yt is to say, my mynde and will is yt John Goerren my eldest sonne shall have y^e some
 of five shillinges of good monny of England to give y^e ~~to~~ to be payd out of
 my goodes to him y^e John Goerren by ~~the~~ my now wife within one Moneth after my
 decease lawfull demaund being made. Item I give unto my sonne Thomas Goerren y^e
 somme of thirty poundes of like monny as aforesaid to be payd out of my goodes to him
 by Thomas by. Alse my now wife within twoo yeares after my decease lawfull demaund
 being made. Item I give unto my daughter Mary y^e now wife of Symond Woolward
 also Howard y^e some of some shillinges of like monny as aforesaid to be payd out of my
 goodes to her y^e Mary y^e now wife of Symond Woolward also Howard by. Alse my
 now wife within one Moneth after my decease lawfull demaund being made. Item
 I give unto my daughter Anne Goerren y^e some of thirty poundes of like monny as
 aforesaid to be payd out of my goodes to her y^e Anne Goerren by. Alse my now
 wife within foure yeares after my decease lawfull demaund being made. Item I
 give unto one payre of shrotes unto John Goerren my eldest sonne within one
 Moneth after my decease lawfull demaund being made. I give unto my sonne
 Thomas Goerren one payre of shrotes within twoo yeares after my decease lawfull
 demaund being made. Item I give unto my daughter Mary y^e now wife of Symond
 Woolward also Howard one payre of shrotes within one Moneth after my decease
 lawfull demaund being made. Item I give unto my daughter Anne Goerren one
 payre of shrotes within foure yeares after my decease lawfull demaund being made.
 Item I give unto my daughter Sarah Goerren y^e somme of thirty poundes of like
 monny as aforesaid and one payre of shrotes to be given and payd out of my goodes to her
 y^e Sarah Goerren by. Alse my now wife within three yeares after my decease lawfull
 demaund being made. Item all goodes not y^e given legated or bequathed
 (my debted payes and funerall regardes deducted) and all other my former giftes and
 legacies discharged I give and fully bequathe unto Alse my now wife whom I
 doe make ordaine constitute and appoynt to be sole executrix of this my last will and
 testament And all other former willed and testam^{nt}. I utterly revoke and by
 these presentes I doe make ordaine constitute and appoynt this my last will and
 testament In witness whereof I have subscribed putt and sett my hande and seale
 the nyth day of May Amongst Som. 1645.
