 Honham in the County of Essex being first of mine of Body yett of perfect minde and memorie prayd to vnto Almighty God for the same
 yett knowinge that my tyme here vpon earth is but short and my life here is vncertaine I doe therefore hereby make and ordaine this my
 last will and Testament in manner and forme followinge Reuoking all other wills by me formerly made first and principally I give and
 bequeath my soule into the hande of Almighty God my maker Saniour and Redeemer And my Body I bequeath to the Earth from whence it was taken
 and to be buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named Item I give and bequeath vnto Richard Hoyo my sonn all my working tooles
 whatsoeuer belonging to my Trade of Wooringe Item I give and bequeath vnto the said Richard Hoyo my sonn one halfe headed bed and a flock
 bedd Item I give and bequeath vnto Ellen Hoyo my daughter all that my freehold Comonment buildings wth the yard orchard andcroft
 or part of arable land I possess thirunto adjoininge vnto the Chappertinanes thirunto belonginge situate lying and being within the Parish
 of Honham in a Hamlett thir called Hledgedon Hamlett and now in the occupation of John Baythorpe or of his Officers to be & remaine
 to the good use & behoefe of the said Ellen Hoyo my daughter for & during the Terme of her natural life and after her decease to
 be & remaine to the heires of the said Ellen Hoyo Lawfully Begotten of her Body forever And for want of such heires I give the
 Comonment Orchard yard buildings & Lande aforesaid vnto Jane Hoyo my grandchild daughter of Richard Hoyo my sonn and to her heires
 and Offspringe forever Item I give and bequeath vnto the said Ellen Hoyo my daughter my bedd & bedden standing in my chamber over
 the hall wherupon I now lye vnto the furniture thir vnto belonging to be deliuered vnto her within one weeke next after my decease
 Item I give and bequeath vnto Richard Hoyo my sonn Elizabeth Gull the wife of John Gull of Eltonham husbandman and to Ellen
 Hoyo my daughter all my monable goods of household stuffe whatsoeuer to be equally parted or diuided betweene them within
 one month next after my decease All the rest of my monable goods & chattells whatsoeuer I give and bequeath vnto Richard
 Hoyo my sonn whom I make sole Executor of this my last will & Testament for witnesse whereof I the said Richard Hoyo
 doe here vnto signe this my will to be written Read and published and hereunto set my hand & Seale the Day & year
 first abovesayd written in the presence of
