 my Body I Commit to the Earth from whence it was taken And to be buried in the Churchyard of Honham aforesaid by my Executors hereafter named, from I give and bequeath unto Francis my well beloved wife the use of that Room called the Chamber in my now dwelling house and convenient Room in my Chamber for the lodging of her bed wood for her orons use I give for during the Term of her natural life with full Liberty of carrying away & removing for her the said Francis or her Assignes for her use to the said Room & yard from I give and bequeath unto the said Francis my wife the halfe yte of all my household stuffe whatsoever Except these things that belongeth to my Trade of Woaninge To be equally used betwix me my Executors and her within three monthes next after my decease from I give and bequeath unto the said Francis my wife the Sum of Thirty Shillings a yeare yearly during the Term of her natural life to be paid unto her quarterly by Equal portions that is to say the Sum of Seven Shillings & six pence the quarter by my Executors hereafter named being lawfully demanded from I give and bequeath unto Robert Giffon my Sonne the Sum of Thirty Shillings of Lawfull money of England to be paid unto him within one yeare next after the decease of Francis my wife being lawfully demanded of my Executors hereafter named from I give and bequeath unto my daughter Francis the wife of Nathaniel Horton of Eabridworth in the County of Hertford the Sum of Twenty Shillings of Lawfull money of England to be paid unto her within one yeare next after the decease of Francis my wife by my Executors hereafter named being lawfully demanded from I give and bequeath unto Mary my daughter the wife of Daniell Hammond of Honham aforesaid the Sum of five poundes of Lawfull money of England to be paid unto her her heire or Assignes within one yeare next after the decease of the said Daniell Hammond by my Executors hereafter named being lawfully demanded from I give and bequeath unto William Giffon my Sonne All that my free and copyhold Tenement whome I now dwell whal the yard & garden and Buildinge whal Chappertinaunt therunto belonging situate within the Parish of Honham aforesaid To be and remaine to the proper use and behoofe of the said William Giffon my Sonne and to his heires and Assignes forever from I give and bequeath unto the said William Giffon my Sonne All my Linnens in my Shoppe and all other my working Tooles belonging to my Trade of Woaninge And all the rest of my movable goods and household stuffe whatsoever not before bequeathed I give and bequeath unto William Giffon my Sonne for and towards the payment of my debts and charges and funerals expences And I doe hereby make and Ordaine the said William Giffon my Sonne sole Executor of this my Last will and Testament In witness whereof I have caused this my will to be written Read published & delivered as my Last will & Testament the Day & yeare first above written
