Dom. 1666 I John Stanes of Henham in the County of Essex husbandman being full of Godys but of perfect minde and memory praised be unto Almighty God for the same yett knowing that my tyme here upon Earth is but short and my life uncerteyn I doe therefore hereby make & declare this my last will & Testament Resolving all other wills by me formerly made first and principally I give & bequeath my soule into the hand of Almighty God my maker Saviour Redeemer and my Body I Commit to the Earth from whence it was taken and to be Buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named Item I give and bequeath unto John Stanes my sonne All my wearing Apparel to be delivered unto him by my Executors hereafter named Item I give and bequeath unto Mary my daughter the wife of Matthew Stungleton the sum of five Shillings to be payd unto her within one halfe year next after my decease by my Executors hereafter named being lawfully demanded Item I give & bequeath unto Elizabeth Stanes my daughter the sum of five Shillings of lawfull money of England to be payd unto her within one year next after my decease by my Executors hereafter named being lawfully demanded Item I give & bequeath unto Louisa Stanes my daughter the sum of five Shillings of lawfull money of England to be payd unto her by my Executors within two years next after my decease being lawfully demanded Item I give & bequeath unto Martha Stanes my daughter the sum of five Shillings of lawfull money of England to be payd unto her by my Executors within three years next after my decease being lawfully demanded All the rest of my movable goods & Chattells whatsoever I give & bequeath unto Louisa my wellbelov'd wife towards the payment of my debts & Expences of funerals Charges And I doe hereby make & ordaine Louisa my wife sole Executor of this my last will & Testament And for witnesse whereof I have hereunto sett my hand and Seale the day and yere first above writton
