 William Wright son of Honham in the County of Essex yeoman being in health and of perfect mind & memory
 praised be unto Almighty God for the same yett knowing that my tyme here upon earth is but shorte and my life
 uncertaine I doo therefore hereby make declare & expresse this to be my last will & Testament touching all other
 former wills by me formerly made, first & principally giving & bequeathing my soule into the hands of Almighty God
 my maker saviour & Redeemer And my Body I commit to the earth from whence it was taken to be Buried at
 the discretion of my Executors hereafter named from hence and bequeath unto William Wright my sonne & that
 my Testament called Exorsheiment shall my Exorsheiment Lande thierunto adjoining & situate within the Parish of
 Honham aforesaid And sheweth upon the highway that leadeth from Dodden towards Stoford of the North side
 & upon the left hand of the west side & upon the Lande belongeth to Honham Hall of the South side & upon the Lande
 of John Jones of the East side to be & remaine to the proper use & behoofe of the said William Wright & of his heires
 & Assignes forever from hence & bequeath unto the said William Wright my sonne the summe of one Shilling of
 Lawfull money of England to be payd unto him by my Executors within one month next after my decease being lawfully
 demanded, from hence & bequeath unto Miss Leade my daughter the summe of ffinie Shillings of Lawfull money of
 England to be payd unto her within one month next after my decease by my Executors being lawfully demanded from
 hence & bequeath unto Elizabeth Nafke my daughter the summe of ffinie Shillings of Lawfull money of England to
 be payd unto her by my Executors within one month next after my decease being lawfully demanded, from hence and
 bequeath unto Mary Wright my daughter the summe of fforty poundes of Lawfull money of England to be payd
 unto her by my Executors within three monthes next after my decease being lawfully demanded from hence
 & bequeath unto John Wright my sonne & to his heires & Assignes forever All that my Chappell or Tomont
 wherof I now dwell with all the Orchardes yards gardenes Barnes Stables & buildings And all my free & copyhold Lande
 within the Parish of Honham aforesaid not before bequeathed, with all furniture Chappellhousehold thierunto belonging
 to be & remaine to the proper use & behoofe of the said John Wright my sonne & of his heires & Assignes forever
 from hence & bequeath unto the said John Wright my sonne All the rest of my movable goods & chattells whatsoever
 towards the payment of my debts & charges & funeral charges And I doo hereby make & ordaine
 the said John Wright my sonne sole Executor of this my last will & Testament and for witnesses
 hereof I have caused this my will to be written read & published And have hereunto set my
 hand & Seale the day & yeare first above written
