orchard & all and synghles & appertyns therunto
belongynge: And also mye close bynge on the
backe syde off mye sayd fre houses to hym and
to be heved and assygned for ever: To have
and to holde all the aforesayd fre houses yards
and lande to the sayd Thomas Bothomley mye
son and to be heved and assygned for ever

Bothomley mye son: mye Crofte called longe
Crofte & all & synghles & appertyns therunto
belongynge bynge in Henham: After the mozt
decease payynge mye depts debts: and other
legases wyll the sayd Thomas Bothomley have
bequethed in thys mye laste wyll and Testamente
