

In the name of God Amen, the seaventh daye of June and in the fortieth yeare of the reigne of our Sovereigne Ladie Elizabeth, by the grace of god, of England, France & Irelande Queene, descendunt of the saythe Richard Botomlye of Henham in the Countie of Essex & Dioces of London Bachelayer being of hole minde & perfecte remembrance Laude glorie and prayse becomene to God therefore, doe make this my Testamente containing in it my last will in mannor and forme first & before all other thinges I bequeathe my soule, to Almighty God & to hys merite, trustinge & assuredlie beleynge that by hys grace & by the merite of the death, passion & resurrection of hys sonne Iesus Christ, I shall have full Remission pardon, and forgiveness of my synnes & resurrection of my bodie & soule and that I shall see my saviour in the last daye & escape of him life everlasting. Item I give and bequeath unto Agnes my wyfe thre my maner or dwelling house in the which I nowe dwell situate & beinge in Henham aforesaide, with the Orchard adioyning thereto for terme of hys life naturall & furthermore, I grant & give unto the saide Agnes my wyfe free leave & libertie by the vertue of this my last will inextortable, for hys better helpe & furthraunce in the education and bringinge up of my children, At hys Will and pleasure, ether to lett or lease thre my sayde messuage or Tenement, with the Orchard therunto belonging at occasion may or shall moue hys thereto, for the space & terme of eyght yeares, and doe grant & allowe it for terme of those ^{yeares} before expressed to be of at full force & effecte after hys death as by the tyme of hys life. Item I give & bequeath unto Steven Chandelor of Henham & in the Countie of Essex about named Pellinham & to hys heires for ever all that parte or partel of my tenement with all the ediffices & bildinges standing & being on the west parte of my now dwelling house towards the church, from my Entree dore abutting vpon the south & soe alonge straitly forth to the fardest parte of one of those bildinges buttynge vpon the north, with the Orchard & soe four yards being a thase waye or passage unto the demised premises with sufficient ground for the cotes droppynge, vpon condition that the aforesaid Steven Chandelor or hys assignes shall paye unto me the about named Richard Botomlye, my heires & executours Administ or Assignes, the summe of twelwe poundes of lawfull English monie twentie daies before the feast daye of ~~St Michael~~ Michael the Archangel nexte ensuynge & daye of the date hereof. Item after the ende of the natural life of Agnes my wyfe & the lease or leases to any person or persons by hys made or granted for the terme of those yeares about mentioned if anye shalbe chaunced to be by hys made or granted being fully compleate & ended, I give & bequeath my sayde messuage or Tenement unto Richard Botomlye, my eldest sonne, with the Orchard therunto adioynge vpon condition that he shall paye such legases or dues to my other as hereafter shalbe by me, unto them given & bequeathed, viz. Item I give & bequeath unto John Botomlye my yongest sonne fourer poundes of lawfull English monie to be payed unto him or to hys Assignes with in one yeare next ensuynge after the death of Agnes my wyfe. Item I give & bequeath unto my daughter Agnes Botomlye fortie shillinges of lawfull English monie to be payed unto hys by my sonne Richard Botomlye within twoe yeares nexte ensuynge after the death of Agnes my wyfe. Item I give & bequeath unto my daughter Marie Botomlye fortie shillinges of lawfull English monie to be payed unto hys by my sonne Richard Botomlye within twoe yeares nexte ensuynge after the death of Agnes Botomlye my wyfe. Item I give & bequeath unto my daughter Thome Botomlye fortie shillinges to be payed on hys by my sonne Richard Botomlye within twoe yeares nexte ensuynge after the death of Agnes my wyfe. I give & bequeath unto Agnes Botomlye my wyfe all my moveables and immoveables not as yett given or bequeathed my funeral charges & all other ordinarie expenss allowed & my debtes payed & of this my last will I doe ordain & make Agnes my wyfe my sole Executrix & I doe earnestly request Henry Clarke of Henham to see my will performed accordyng to the purpoise & true meaning thereof.
