Item I bequeth to the high altare of my parische church for my offeringe forgotten or negligently witheraway in discharginge of my soule 2 s. Item I bequeth to wardes the stange vpe ryght of the wether. wher at most neede is. 2 s. Item I bequeth to my daughter joone cleve 2 s. Item I bequeth to either of my other daughters 2 s. Item I will & myne executors here under writen se me honestly buried. and my either of them dispose perely for me at my anniversary in the said church for my soule & all christen soules in myn house & landes & all thinge as well in the parishes of heston & downe as in the parishes of henry. for the tennue of thre lyfe naturall (the lordes rentes paid) and also I geve & bequeth unto hire all my goodes movables & debts what soever they be (my debts paid. my funeralles & expenses fully done. & the legacies conteyned in this my present testament performed) she to doo & dispose the same after hir owne frewill & disposition. and to doo for me as she will & shal for hir in case semblable. and of this my present testament & last will I make & ordeyne myne executors my sonnes John & Thomas. and ther oversesers of the same I make & ordeyne John cleve the parson & Robert penyngton wherof were they p'sent James lambe prest. p'p'ser bendall. William carter with other moor.
