I bequeit to Mary day my daughter
xij s to be paid to the sayd Mary
at xx years of her age or els at the
day of her marriage at whiche of them
that shall first happen thus I bequeit to
Anne day my daughter likewise
xij s to be paid to the sayd Anne
at xx years of her age or els at the
day of her marriage at whiche of them
that shall first happen thus I bequeit to
the sayd Anne one ewe thus I bequeit
to Mary day my daughter xij s to
be paid to the sayd Mary at xx
years of her age or els at the day
of her marriage at whiche of them
that shall first happen I bequeit to
the sayd Mary one ewe thus I bequeit
Robert day my sonne one Cowe
to be delivered to the sayd Robert at
xx years of his age finally all the
reast of my goodes both movables
and immovables not bequeitied
I bequeit to him to Clement day
my wife towards the bringing upp of
my said children and I make the
sayd Clement my wife the wife
Executour of this my last will
and testament. Thus signed
witnesses of the same.
