 among the poure people of the parisshe.
 Item I bequeth to my seruant John
 Robt xxij. Item I bequeth to ^{my daughter} ~~my daughter~~
 Anne my best gone. or elys xx.
 Item I bequeth to all p^rete cole of my
 my horse conditionally that his father geue
 vnto my wyf a sufficient horse to goo to the
 myle or elys xxij. Item I bequeth to my
 wife or elys xxij. Item I bequeth to my
 wife or elys xxij.

The residue of all my goodes movabiles
 & debts. what so ever they be. my debtors
 & debtors I give to alio guthard my
 wyff. whome I do constitute & make my
 sole executor & executrix. And John Sander
 with her And of this my last testament
 & last will I do make & ordeyne John
 Robt overseers of the same. In witness
