Redemour and saviour Trustinge assuredly by the merites deathe and Resurrection
of Jesus Christe to obtayne p[er]petuall freyson of eternall lyfe and my Bodye to be
Buried in the Church yerde of that p[ar]ish where in it shall please almyghty god
that my bodye and soule shall departe from this worlde Item I gene and bequeeth
unto Elizabeth my wyfe all that my messuage or tenement called Brogher wyche
I nowe dwell in together with the yerd and garden and all other appurtenances
belonginge to the same sett lyng and beinge with in the p[ar]ish of St. James aforesayde
to have and to holde the same messuage with the yerd and garden adjoyninge
and all other Commodities and appurtenances belonginge to the same to the sayde
Elizabeth my wyfe and to here heires and assignes for ever Item I gene
and bequeeth unto Richard Hockleye of vglyngge my best fether bedd my best
bolster and my best Concyng to have and to enjoy the same immediately
after my deathe Item I will that if my wyfe be disposed to sell anye of
my goodes that then the sayde Richard Hockleye shall have the first
offer and p[re]ferment therof geninge for them as others well be content
to gene for them The Residue of all and singular my goodes lease or leses
and Chattels what soever aswell Real as p[er]sonall I gene and bequeeth
them fullye and whollie to the sayde Elizabeth my wyfe whom I doo ordaine
and make my Executrix of this my last will and testament Together with
Richard Hockleye of vglyngge aforesayde Into whose handes I doo p[er]mitte
deliv[er] this writinge subscribed and sealled with my maner and
seale at my owne and p[er]fite wyl and testament In the presence
of John Smith Clarke the wytt[er] herof and Richard Hockleye my
offert Charyngge my sayde wyfe at her wyl amfoure before god
that shee paye my debtes as farre as my good wyl her unto
Receyve or extend
