 of brass. Item I give to the said Anne my daughter one ruffband. Item I give to the said Anne my daughter one
 with a mattress one ruffband one blanket one bolster one pillow & one pair of sheets. Item I give to James Porter
 my son in law one standing bed one floorboard & one pair of scotches. Item I give to Margaret my daughter
 the sum of ten pounds of good & lawful money of England to be paid unto her by my Executor within
 one year next after my decease. Item I will that all the residue of my goods not before given & bequeathed
 equally divided between Mary Porter my daughter and Anne my daughter. Item I give unto Anne my daughter
 the sum of ten pounds of good & lawful money of England to be paid unto her by my Executor
 within one year next after my decease. And I will always that if it shall please God that I live to spend
 of my goods at that my Executor shall not give sufficient goods of mine left to discharge the legacies be me
 in this my last will & testament given and bequeathed that then my said Executor shall not be responsible
 nor bound to pay the legacies but to abate out of all my residue
 legacies equally and proportionally. Item I make & ordain Anne Glascock my daughter sole
