 too daughters within too yeres after my decess I am I give unto rather in pence of good
 and lawfull monye of Englonde to be payed within too yeres after my decess And I make James
 hebeard and Johan my daughter my full and wholle exors sence these my gyftes to be
 payed and to bringe my bodye honeste on earth. And I appoynte George Haydon my brother to
 be overseer of this my laste will and testament And I give hym for his payment of p^{re}sent
 in p^{re}sent wherof I have sette my hand the daye and yere abond written - And all I give to Anable
 my god daughter vid^l viijth to be payed by my too daughters within too yeres after my
 decess and all the rest of my moveable ^{good} not yet gyven I give them to my exors
