and over that I wylle charge that she see me honestly buriede and my seventh day and my moneth
monde and yere mynde kepte wylle in my paryshe church of henlyng and also I wylle that she kepe
to my sayde church an obit at longe at the lybr for my soules and all crysten soules and the day
of my decess I wylle that she deliver ij breue to the church warden of henlyng to entent the sayde ob
may be kepte for ever. The residue of all my movable goodes and deff what soever the be my
deff payde my funeralle and expensed fully done and the legacies conteyned in this my present
testament pformed. I geve and bequeethe holly unto alid stamp my wyffe whome I make my
sole executrice. she to dyspose the same after hire own fre wylle and to do for me as she wolde
side for hire in case semblable. Also it is the last wylle of me the said John Stamp that the said
alid my wyffe shall have and holde to hire and to hire assyes for terme of lyff naturally. my wylle wylle or
consentment wylle the appurtenance and all my free holdes & copy holdes sett & lounge in the paryshe of henlyng and
after the decess of the alid my wyffe I wylle that my overseers here under wylle sell the said tenement
wylle the pmisses by the advice and counsell of maister vicare and the chydemen of the said paryshe all
Journede to gether of on assent and I wylle that the money that comyth the res be dysposed by the discrecion of
sayd psones in alme dedes for the welthe of my soules my wyffes soules and all crysten soules. And of this
my present testament and last wylle I make and ordeyn my brother Richard Stamp and John molle the younger
overseers and I bequeethe to any one of them to see thye my present testament pformed and
