Also I bequeathe to the same folks beynge in the same churche & pyd. Item I bequeathe unto John my sonne A holocke of 11 year of age. And unto ffiamme my sonne an other holocke of 11 year of age to be delivred unto them when they do come unto the ages of xvth year. Item I bequeathe to ffabelle my daughter Agnes my daughter & also my daughter to have one of them A holocke of 11 year olds to be delivred when & as they do come unto the said age of ffifteen year. Item I gyve and bequeathe to Katherine my goddaughter A holocke of 11 year of age to be delivred at the feaste of S^{ct} Michael the churche of Symbysshe nexte ensynge after my deceasse. Item I bequeathe to my wyther my blacke fyve yeres 11 loom carthes & one for the holye daye & A newe lepen smock. Item I bequeathe to the forsaide ffabelle my daughter A yoke & a tache of sylver. Also I bequeathe to the forsaide my daughter my second yoke & a paye of hokes of sylver. Item I wyll & bequeathe that all my householde stuffe shalbe equallye divided amonys my forsaide sonnes & daughters. And al my lymen what so evn it be. to be equallye divided amonys my said daughters. And if any of my said daughters do fortune to deceasse. That then I wyll her ptes & ptes so beynge deceassed to be equallye divided amonys the other of my said daughters then beynge alive. Item I wyll & bequeathe that the forsaide John my sonne & ffabelle my daughter of Symbysshe aforesaid shalbe hand holde & occupye all my land & Tent aforesaid ffre as they beynge be in the said churche of Symbysshe together wth all maner of pfitte of them synysse & comynge onlye to have the p^{er}formance & fullfyllinge of my said late husband wyll & payng all maner of legacies & debtes in his said wyll comysed and specified. And they to be in the same power strength & auctorite that I have in or hope after shoulde be by the beynge of his said Testament untill my said chylde do come to the age in the said wyll limited & appoynted. And for the better p^{er}formance & fullfyllinge of my said late husband wyll & this my last wyll & testament I ordeyne & make thesaid John my sonne & the forsaide ffabelle my daughter to be myne executours & faithfull attornies. These beynge mynnes John Corrye the said John holler John Corrye Thome Corrye Roger Corrye & John John & other more gyven the day & year aforesaid.

 and god and yfthe p^remises beinge (landed be god) do ordeyne and make this my last
 testament contynynge my last wyll in maner & forme followynge / firste and principallie I gyve
 and comend my Soule unto almighty god & my bodye to be buryed in the churche of Wymbessey
 of Wymbessey aforesaid / Also I bequeathe to the poore folkes bye in the same churche a p^ryd from
 I bequeathe unto John my sonne a booke of y^e yere of age And unto Thomas my sonne an other
 booke of y^e yere of age to be delivred unto them when they do come unto the age of xx yere
 And I bequeathe to my daughter Marye a booke of y^e yere of age to be delivred unto her when she do come
 out of her a booke of y^e yere of age to be delivred when she do come unto the age of fifteen yeres
 of fifteen yeres / And I gyve and bequeathe to Katherine Overton my goddaughter a
 booke of y^e yere of age to be delivred at the feaste of S^r Michael the Archangel the
 nexte daye after my deceasse / And I bequeathe to my mother my blene first gowne y^e I borrow
 dargers & one for the yere daye and a newe flosser Smocke / And I bequeathe to the forsaide
 Isabell my daughter a gowne & a cappe of Sylver / Also I bequeathe to the forsaide
 Marye my daughter my seconde gowne & a payre of shoes of Sylver / And I wyll and
 bequeathe that all my household stuffe shalbe equallye devyded amongst my forsaide sonnes and
 daughters / And all my hennys to be equallye devyded amongst my forsaide daughters / And if any of my
 forsaide daughters do fortune to deceasse that then I wyll for the or the yere so longe deceassed to
 be equallye devyded amongst the other of my forsaide daughters for longe abyde / And I wyll
 and bequeathe that the forsaide John my sonne and wylliam wyght of Wymbessey aforesaid shalbe
 have hold and occupie all my lande and tementys wholle free as they shalbe beinge wth the
 forsaide of Wymbessey together wth all maner of giftes of t^rem yf anye comynge toward the
 p^rformance and fulfillinge of my forsaide alate husbandes wyll praynge all maner of legacies
 & debtes in his forsaide wyll comysed and especyfyed And to be in the same p^rovys stronge and
 unrevocable that I am in as yet after shoulde be by the vertue of his forsaide testament untill my
 forsaide husbande do come to daye in the forsaide wyll limited and appoynted / And for the p^rovys
 p^rformance and fulfillinge of my forsaide alate husbandes wyll and this my laste wyll and
 testament I ordeyne and make the forsaide John my sonne and the forsaide wylliam wyght to be
 myn exors^r and faithfull attornys / These beinge wytnesses John Somer the elder
 John Corbly John wyght Thomas wyght Roger Somer and John John no other mo
 gyven the daye and yere aforesaid
