 my last will and testament at the day of my
 buriall in bread and drinke and of the residue
 of the poore people aforesaid. Item I make my will
 and give my sonnes my executors. And my sonne
 I have myne overseer of this my last will and testament
 the presence of Clemente daye of Januarye in the
 of the reign of our sovereign Ladye Elizabeth by the
 grace of god queene of England France and Ireland
 defendour of the faith &c. the first daye

I will and bequeyte all the above money and
 legacies to be paid by the hands of myne sonne
 Nicholas myne executor to whom I give and
 give power that my house and land
 above specified
