 in bedd but of god and good memory thank be to god, we
 make and ordeyne this my last will and Testament in maner
 followinge first & principally I geve my soule into the hand of
 Almighty god and my body to be buryed in the churchyard of
 London aforesaid, Item I geve and bequeath unto Amye my wif
 one of my Tenement called Mayge with all my fire and every
 gold and silver adorninge wherbyng by estimation one hundred more
 or lesse duringe her naturall life and after her decease I
 will the same shall remaine to John Ford my wifes sonne
 and to his heirs for ever & exceptinge one little Tenement or
 cottage taken out of the same which is now builded upon
 the same my selfe called warden late in the occupation of one
 Thomas Wolston and also a house wherin I geve and bequeath
 unto Amye my wif and to her heirs for ever, Item I geve
 unto one of my kith or kint Stock my sonne of the age
 of lawfull memory of England to be payed within one yere
 next after my decease, All the rest of my good and
 chattels not bequeathed I geve and bequeath unto Amye
 my wif to have and to do with my sole executour of this my
 last will and Testament so that she my dette and to
 pay my legacies aforesaid, Also I geve unto
 the poore people of London aforesaid my part of lawfull
 money of England to be payed at the day of my buryall
 by my said executour
