155 the sum of 100 shillings yearly until the said full sum of 100 shillings
should be fully satisfied and paid / Item more I give
and bequeath to my said daughter Anne ~~for~~ at the day of her marriage
age to be delivered to her my said daughter Anne
the sum of 100 shillings or so much of money as the gift of my said
daughter / more I give to my said daughter Anne
at her said marriage to be delivered at the day of her marriage
age / Altho my mind and will is that my said daughter Anne
shall have full power to use and dispose the said 100 shillings to use
for all her good comfort and the day out of her life
before the said full sum shall be due and paid, by her will.
Item to my daughter Elizabeth my wife I give and bequeath the
sum of 100 shillings made of lawful money of England, to be paid
the first in one year next after the last payment, of the said 100 shillings
to be paid to Anne as aforesaid / more I will
that my daughter Elizabeth only she be entitled to all remain
I have for meat drink and cloth Anne only my son Richard
for the space of 10 years next after my decease at his wife
and age, of the said daughter Anne so long keep her

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth
to be paid her at the age of 21 years. Item I give
Anne my daughter of my said daughter Elizabeth
I give and bequeath unto her of London free English money to be
paid her at the age of 21 years and my myrror
I will is that none of her shall be paid to her
And furthermore my myrror and will is that if my said
daughter Elizabeth shall be paid to die and depart before
her time that her said daughter shall be paid before

debtors and my body reverently brought to the ground
with my said son I make my testament and appoint
my said son and lawful Executors to have my last will
I do revoke & utterly disannul all former wills and
testaments & legacies not by this will made or made.
And I make and appoint my natural 13 shillings one halfpenny
and will be paid unto my said son of my last will I give
and in regard of my daughter's portion I give to my said son
10 shillings & subscribed with my own hand and seal
the day and year above written in the presence & sight of
George my clerk and others my witnesses with my seal
