 what soeuer under these names & title continued not as yett give & bequeathed
 I give & bequeathe unto ~~my~~ Bridget Hall daughter of my said
 brother Steven Hall to see my bodie brought & orderd to the earth & my
 funerall expences allowed, & of that my last will I doe ordaine & make the
 soueraine Bridget Hall my sole & only Exekutor. // : // . // : 1608
