 the greatt Chamber in my habitation & shalbe paid & solmied unto my savior by the Executor
 & Executrix or by one of them in their hys or either of their sones Executors or Administrators
 in or at the Manerhouse of John Meade my fatherlyne situate in Borden Callod & knowne
 by the name of ~~the~~ or by what other name & title it is knowne or called by
 when my savior John White shall accomplish the age of one & twentie yeres Item all
 the residue of my good not yett Given nor bequeathed I have given & bequeath unto Sara White
 my wyfe to paye my debt to see my bodye broughtt orderly to the earth & my funerall charges
 expenses allowed & paid dent of this my laste will I doe ordaine constitute & make my savior
 wyfe & my fatherlyne John Meade of Hallingbury Magna my Executor and Executrix
 together & I doe earnestly request James Bowtell of Galford in the County
 of Essex yonged to see the due execution of this my laste will & doe ordaine & make him my ad-
 visor In witness whereof I have herunto putt my hand & seale the daye & yere first
 above written
