thirty and seven I John Hanson of Exhant in the County of Dorset
being yet in body but of a short memory (swayed by god the
good god make and ordaine this my last will and Testament in
first I commend my soule unto Almighty god my Creator hoping a
joyfull and a ioyfull resurrection and my body to the earth to be buried
in the Churchyard of Exhant and for my worldly good the which
the lord hath blessed me withall I bequeath them in manner as
followeth I give and bequeath unto my daughter Susan
wife of William Carter of Stobbing the sum of five pounds
per annu if she then be living or otherwise within twelve monethes after
my decease if she then be living otherwise I bequeath it unto her
children Elizabeth and William equally to be divided betwixt them
if they then be living I give and bequeath unto my daughter
Susan the wife of Richard Wallis the sum of five pounds
per annu if she then be living or otherwise I bequeath it unto her
two daughters Mary and Joan
equally to be divided betwixt them if they then be living I give
and bequeath unto my son Samuel Hanson the sum of twenty
shillings to be paid unto him within twelve monethes after my
decease I give and bequeath unto the seven children of my said son
Hanson the sum of forty shillings to be paid unto them when they
shall Attainfull the yeres of Twenty and one or at the day of
their marriages equally to be divided amongst them I give and
bequeath unto my son Peter Hanson the sum of six pounds
per annu conditionally that he shall discharge my debts from one Henry
Stanford Mountfithell to be paid within one yere and a halfe after
my decease if he then be living otherwise I give and bequeath it
unto my daughter Susan the sum of twenty pounds to be paid immediately after my
decease I give and bequeath unto the three children of my said son
William Hanson thirty shillings equally to be divided amongst
them when they shall Attainfull the yeres of Seventeen and six
all the rest of my moveables and unmoveables chattells bills bonds debts
or dues owing to me my debts being paid and my funerall expences
discharged I give and bequeath them unto my wife Elizabeth
whome I nominate and appoint executrix of this my last will and
Testament and I intimate that Edward Menehead to be overseer of
my last will and Testament signed John Hanson published and
declared this last will and Testament in the presence of John Wallis
Hugh Lateliff and
