 sufficient mind and memory (thanks be unto God) doo hereby make and ordaine his my last
 testament containing herein my last will in manner and formes following vizt First and
 principally I comitt my soule into the hands and protection of almighty God my lord King
 and stedfastly believing that through the bitter death and passion of Iesus Christ my only lord
 and saviour I shall have free redemption of all my sinne and my body to the ground to be
 decently and comely buried and as for and concerning all my personall estate lands goods
 chattells movables and whatsoever it hath pleased God to make me a steward of I give and
 bequeath in manner and formes following Inprimis I give and bequeath unto my
 wellbelovd wife Dearbara Mortlocke all my lands both terry and free lying and being
 in howfields platfields and hides and one hundred pounds of good and lawfull money of
 England and alsoe the house I bought of Robert Wright withall the appurtenances and how
 ever I come to my sonne John I doo give and bequeath one hundred shillings and five
 pounds of lawfull money of England to be paid within one year after my decease Item
 to my sonne Thomas I doo give and bequeath three hundred pounds of lawfull money
 of England to be paid when he cometh of one and twenty years of age Item to my sonne
 Edward I doo give and bequeath three hundred pounds of good and lawfull money of England
 to be paid when he cometh at one and twenty years of age Item to my daughter
 Margaret I doo give and bequeath five pounds of good and lawfull money of England
 to be paid within two years after my decease Item to my daughter Mary I doo give
 and bequeath twenty pounds and twenty pounds unpaid in all forty pounds to be paid
 within one year after my decease Item to my Grandchild Mary Mortlocke I
 doo give and bequeath twenty pounds to be paid at her day of marriage Item to
 the poor of Donham I doo give forty shillings Item to James Hellam Clerk
 I doo give and bequeath five pounds Item to my sonne Samuel I doo give
 and bequeath forty shillings Item I doo hereby appointe and nominate ordaine
 and make my loving wife Dearbara Mortlocke and my sonne John Mortlocke
 Executrix and Executor of this my last will and Testament and revoke all other
 wills by me made **Witness** hereto James Hellam and Barbara
 Mortlocke the Executrix.
