 Sixty of age but of perfect minde and memory prayd to God for the Same, and knowinge that
 this life upon Earth is vncertaine, I doe hereby make this my last will and Testament in
 maner and forme followinge, first and principally I give and bequeath my Soule into the hande of
 Almighty God my maker Saviour and Redeemer And my body I commit to the Earth from whence
 it was taken to be buried all the direction of my Executors hereafter named Item I give and
 bequeath unto Anne my wife all that my ffres house Land and Tenement wh thappertinaunt
 where in I now dwell with the buildinge thirbut belonging Situate within the Parish of Eynham
 aforesaid During her naturall life and after her decease unto my daughter Anne Saull and to her
 heires for ever, And if it shall happen my daughter Anne Saull to departe this life without Issue
 then I give and bequeath all my said ffres house Land Tenement and buildinge wh thappertinaunt
 thirbut belonging Situate within the Parish of Eynham aforesaid unto my brother Thomas Saull
 and to his heires for ever, after the decease of Anne my wife who is now with child and shalbe delivered of a Sonne and so forth then I give and bequeath
 the said ffres house Land and Tenement wh thappertinaunt which I before bequeathed unto my daughter
 Anne Saull unto that Sonne and to his heires for ever After the decease of Anne my wife upon
 condition that he shall paye unto my daughter Anne Saull the full and whole Summe of two
 hundred pound of good and lawfull money of England to be payd unto her when shew shall accomplish
 the age of One and twenty years And if my said Sonne shall refuse to paye the said Summe of two
 hundred pound at aforesaid then I give and bequeath unto my said daughter Anne Saull and to her
 heires for ever the aforesaid ffres house Land and Tenement wh thappertinaunt After the decease of
 Anne my wife and for want of heires I give and bequeath the aforesaid ffres house Land and Tenement
 unto my brother Thomas Saull and to his heires for ever, after the decease of Anne my wife And if
 my wife shall have a daughter I then give and bequeath the aforesaid ffres house Land and Tenement
 wh thappertinaunt to be equally divided betweene them after the decease of Anne my wife And if
 it shall happen my Sonne daughter or daughter to departe all of them this life without Issue then
 I give the said ffres house Land and Tenement unto my brother Thomas Saull and to his heires for ever
 after the decease of Anne my wife, And if it shall happen my Sonne daughter or daughter to
 departe this life without Issue then I give and bequeath all that my ffres house Land and buildinge
 wh thappertinaunt within the Parish of Stausted in the County of Essex unto my brother George Saull and to his
 heires for ever upon condition that my said brother George Saull shall paye unto my brother
 John Saull or his heires the full and whole Summe of Sixty pound of good and lawfull money of
 England within one year after the decease of my children And for want of payment I give and
 bequeath the said ffres house Land and buildinge wh thappertinaunt Containing by estimation Sixty Acres
 more or lesse unto my brother John Saull and to his heires for ever Item I give and bequeath unto
 my daughter Anne Saull the Summe of ffifty pound of good and lawfull money of England to be payd
 unto her within twelve years after my decease by my Executors hereafter named All the rest
 of my movable goods and chattels whatsover I give and bequeath unto Anne my wellbelovd wife
 whom I make Sole Executrix of this my last will and Testament trusting all other wills by me
 formerly made in witness whereof I the said Edward Saull have hereunto sett my hand and Seale
 the day and year above written
