And I also intreat all my other friends to discharge the said John Moyzant the younger that I have trusted them with
I give and bequeath to my brother and sister and their children one penny a piece over and above
that which I have formerly given unto them. Item all the right that I have in late house garden or
orchard in Broomham aforesaid by lease or otherwise I give it to my wellbelov'd Anne Durdon of Broomham
aforesaid spinster during the time she shall remaine a single woman. provided that she place no other
bodis there but onely for herselfe. or such as my brother Moyzant shall thinke well of. Item I give my
foryard and house. and table with the house and forme to god with the house and forme
will and meaning is that if she the said Anne shall place any bodis in the aforesaid house or forme for herselfe
without the consent of my said brother or his successors then and thenceforth her right and title of the same
shall cease and end. except she shall take my executor. Item I give and bequeath unto my wellbelov'd
and unto me belonginge before devised. I give unto her and for assigned for ever to have and
upon immediately after my decease. And I commit to her the same and keeping the same from time to time
at all times and seasons that I shall be out of place or require to do it my selfe. And I make my brother
Thomas Moyzant my executor. which if he faile to undertake for me. then I intreat my wellbelov'd
Anne aforesaid to be my executrix in this regard. In witness to this my last will I the said John Moyzant
have put to set my hand and seale this my last and twentieth day of August in the year of our Lord god one
thousand five hundred and fiftie and fourth the day of August in the year of our Lord god one
